Atmos Energy Corporation herewith submits for filing the 6<sup>th</sup> Revised Sheet No. 44 for all areas of Missouri which replaces the 5<sup>rd</sup> Revised Sheet No. 44.

This filing reflects a decrease in rates for all the areas of Missouri. As a result of this filing a typical residential customer in the West Area (Old Butler) will experience a decrease of approximately 61.93%; in the West Area (Old Greeley) a decrease of approximately 77.49%, in the Southeastern Area (Old SEMO) a decrease of approximately 61.15%; in the Southeastern Area (Old Neelyville) a decrease of approximately 64.17%, in the Kirksville Area a decrease of approximately 49.04%, and in the Northeastern Area a decrease of approximately 60.51%.

## Please note these schedules replace the Percentage of PGA Increase/ Decrease, Tariff Page 44 and Exhibits 1 filed in October 2008.
