2.9 DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

Service continues to be provided until canceled, by Customer, in writing, or until canceled by Carrier as set forth below.

- .1 Cancellation by Customer - Customer may have service discontinued 30 days after giving notice to Carrier.
