# **ORDER CORRECTING ORDER GRANTING FINANCING APPLICATION**

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Issue Date: December 14, 2022

Effective Date: December 19, 2022

On August 1, 2022, Confluence Rivers Utility Company, Inc. ("Confluence") submitted applications requesting authority to issue long-term debt to CoBank, ACB ("CoBank") in an amount not to exceed \$7.2 million. Confluence's applications also seek authority to secure this long-term indebtedness by granting CoBank a statutory lien on all equity Confluence owns now and will own in the future, as well as a perfected priority lien on, and security interest in, all real and personal, tangible and intangible, present and future assets of Confluence. Confluence is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Central States Water Resources, Inc. The Commission granted Confluence's Financing Application on November 9, 2022.

On December 12, 2022, Confluence filed a motion for clarification/correction and expedited treatment, explaining that CoBank objected to language in the order issued on November 9, granting the financing application. Confluence stated that language from the first paragraph of the order indicated that the Commission intended to approve Confluence's request for "... authority to secure this long-term indebtedness by granting CoBank a statutory lien on all equity Confluence owns now and will own in the future, as

well as a perfected priority lien on, and security interest in, all real and personal, tangible and intangible, present and future assets of Confluence." The first ordered paragraph of the Commission's order omits certain portions of this request, and Confluence requests that the order be corrected to include a grant for the entire requested authority in its ordered paragraphs.

Confluence stated that it has a rate block that expires on December 21, 2022, for its financing, and requested the Commission expedite its request because failure to close on financing will result in additional costs to Confluence and its customers, and it would be in the interest of the public to issue an order clarifying or correcting the financing order immediately.

Confluence states that Staff and OPC do not object to the relief requested in its December 12<sup>th</sup> motion. There are no other parties.

The Commission finds Confluence's requests for clarification/correction and expedited treatment reasonable and will grant them.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The first ordered paragraph of the Commission's November 9, 2022 Order

Granting Financing Application is corrected to state as follows:

Confluence's application requesting authority to issue long-term debt to CoBank in an amount not to exceed \$7.2 million, and to secure the long-term indebtedness by granting CoBank a lien on all equity Confluence owns now, and will own in the future, as well as a perfected priority lien on, and security interest in, all real and personal, tangible and intangible, present and future assets of Confluence, is granted.

2. All other aspects of the Commission's November 9, 2022 Order Granting

Financing Application remain unchanged.

3. This order shall be effective December 19, 2022.

4. This file shall be closed on December 21, 2022.
