## ORDER RE-SCHEDULING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING AND ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

Issue Date: January 13, 2011

Effective Date: January 13, 2011

The Missouri Public Service Commission is scheduling a local public hearing, with a presentation and question-and-answer session, and providing for notice as follows.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Missouri Public Service Commission will convene a public meeting, which will consist of a presentation, a question-and-answer session, and a local public hearing.

The date, time and place shall be:

The public meeting shall proceed as follows:

- a. At **5:30 p.m.**, the Commission's staff shall make a presentation about this action, followed by a question and answer session to discuss the issues.
- b. At **6:00 p.m.** or the conclusion of the question-and-answer session, whichever occurs later, a regulatory law judge shall convene the local public hearing, at which persons interested in this action may testify.
- c. When all persons present have had the opportunity to be heard, the local public hearing shall conclude.

All proceedings shall be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act, and any person needing additional accommodations to participate shall call the Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 no later than the day before the hearing.

2. At the public meeting, KMB Utility Corporation, the Commission's staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel each shall each:

- a. Prepare a written statement of its perspective, not more than one page, with sufficient copies for distribution at the presentation.
  - b. Make at least one representative available in person at the question-and-answer session to set forth any perspective it has on this action, address substantive issues, and respond to questions from the audience.
3. KMB Utility Corporation shall give its water service customers notice including the following language.

### **NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE INCREASE AND PUBLIC MEETING**

KMB Utility Corporation ("KMB") filed a proposal with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("PSC") that may affect your water bill. KMB proposes to increase its gross annual revenues from all its water service territories (excluding sales and other gross receipts taxes) by \$[xx.xx] in the aggregate.

For the [territory], the overall increase proposed is \$[xx.xx]. For the typical [territory] residential customer using x gallons per [billing period], **the proposed increase would be approximately \$xx.xx per [billing period]**, if this rate request is approved in full.

If you would like to comment on KMB's proposal, you may do so in several ways:

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  - c. When all persons present have had the opportunity to be heard, the local public hearing shall conclude.

Comments are viewable by the public. **Do not include any information in a public comment that you do not wish to be made public.**

This event will be held in buildings that meet accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. For each bracketed variable in that language, KMB Utility Corporation shall substitute the relevant information.

4. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the governing body of each county, or city not within a county, in the water service territories of KMB Utility Corporation.

5. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to members of the General Assembly representing the residents in the water service territories of KMB Utility Corporation.

6. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
