# SUPPLEMENT TO NON-UNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT REGARDING REVENUE INCREASES AMONG THE VARIOUS CUSTOMER CLASSES

Come now the undersigned parties in this case ("Signatories"), and respectfully state to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

- 1. At the Agenda Meeting held on August 10, 2016, the Commission requested that the Signatories file a supplement to the Non-Unanimous Stipulation And Agreement filed July 29, 2016 ("Agreement") which identified and stipulated into the record the pre-filed testimony that supported the recommendations contained in the Agreement.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's request, the Signatories stipulate into the evidence of this case the following pre-filed testimony and portions of the Staff Report which the Signatories state support the recommendations contained in the Agreement:
