On September 18, 2008, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an Order Approving Disposition Agreement, Approving Tariff and Closing Case. In that order, the Commission noted that "[the agreement] resulted in an agreed-upon decrease in revenues of \$2.182."

Also, on September 18, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion to correct that sentence in the Commission's order. Staff points out that although the income statement generated by Staff shows a \$2,182 decrease in revenue, the parties actually agreed to continue consumer rates at the current level.

The Commission will grant Staff's motion to correct the order to accurately reflect what the parties agreed to. Rather than "[t]his resulted in an agreed-upon decrease of \$2,182 in revenues", the penultimate sentence in the second paragraph shall be: "Although the income statement shows a decrease of \$2,182 in revenues, the parties agreed that the existing rates are sufficient for the company to recover its cost of service."

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Staff of the Commission's motion is granted.
- 2. The Commission order shall be corrected as set out in the body of this order.

3. This order shall become effective September 29, 2008.
