JEFFERSON CITY – The Missouri Public Service Commission will be sponsoring its first “Utility Days” on **Friday, October 14** at the **Chesterfield Mall in St. Louis County**. The public is invited to meet with regulators, utility representatives and the Office of Public Counsel (the state’s consumer advocate).

“Utility regulation is very complex. There is a lot more involved than just flipping a switch or turning on the faucet,” said PSC chairman Kevin Gunn. “We hope these events are educational. We want to give people an opportunity to discuss problems and provide information that may help resolve these issues.”

“Utility Days” are designed to provide the public with information and education in a “one-stop shop” setting. The event will be held **Friday, October 14 from 10:30 a.m. to 7 p.m.** at the lower level of the mall near Macy’s.
