## ORDER EXTENDING TIMELINE

On April 10, 2012, the Commission's Staff filed a motion stating that it and Oakbrier Water Company have agreed the Small Utility Rate Case Timeline should be extended to allow Staff and the company an additional 60 days to negotiate a disposition agreement. The Commission's rule, 4 CSR 240-3.050(12), allows for such an extension if it is agreed to by Staff and the company.

Given the agreement of Staff and Oakbrier, the Commission will grant Staff's motion and will adopt the extended timeline proposed by Staff.
