## ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE DISPOSITION AGREEMENT

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Motion for Extension of Time to File Disposition Agreement*<sup>1</sup> ("motion") filed by Staff.

Staff seeks a 60-day extension of time to file the disposition agreement that the Commission's regulations require in a small utility rate action.<sup>2</sup> The Commission's regulations allow an extension of two months upon agreement of the parties.<sup>3</sup> Staff cites the extraordinary environmental and financial problems of Hickory Hills Water & Sewer, Inc. ("Hickory Hills"), the subject small utility, and states that the parties are continuing their discussions. From those representations, we infer that all parties agree to the extension.<sup>4</sup>

Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Motion for Extension of Time to File Disposition Agreement is granted.
- 2. The disposition agreement shall be filed no later than June 30, 2014.
