#### Dear Customer:

On December 1, 2014, Village Greens Water Company (Company) submitted a request for an increase in its annual water operating revenues to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission). The reason for the increase is to cover increases in expenses and/or investments in the Company's facilities.

By its request, the Company is seeking changes to its customer rates intended to generate an increase in its annual water operating revenues of \$2,400 (approximately 7.5%), respectively.
