### STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO PREPARE SCENARIOS

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and for its *Response* to the Commission's *Order Directing Staff to Prepare Scenarios*, states as follows:

- 1. On May 11, 2016, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Staff to Prepare Scenarios*, in which it directed Staff to prepare and file on May 16, 2016, scenarios as follows:
  - 1. Assume that Missouri-American's water service is consolidated into the three water-rate districts proposed by Staff; assume a single block volumetric design for all customers as proposed by Missouri-American; assume a state-wide customer charge of \$15.33 per month; assume the purchased power allocation in Missouri-American's class cost of service study is not modified as proposed by MIEC; assume that Missouri-American's proposal to limit allocation of Administrative and General costs to \$20 per customer for each sewer district is adopted, and finally, assume that Missouri-American's existing sewer districts are consolidated to two districts as proposed by Missouri-American. For that scenario:
    - a. If the Arnold sewer district's rates are capped at \$33.58 per month as promised by Missouri-American, is there a revenue shortfall in the Arnold district, and if so, how much is that shortfall.
    - b. Assuming Missouri-American's customers will not be required to pay for any shortfall resulting from the cap on Arnold's rates, what is the effect on customer rates for each water and sewer district?

- 2. Same scenario as 1, except that Missouri-American's existing sewer districts are consolidated into five districts as proposed by Staff.
- 2. The attached sheets are an estimate of proposed impacts based upon the Commission's direction as put forth in the Order for Scenario. For water customers, the two attached scenarios are the Staff's and Company's interpretation of the order. The basic difference between the two is that Staff's customer classes in Districts 2 (St. Joseph, et al.) and 3 (Joplin, et al.) are Residential, Commercial, Industrial, Other Public Authority (OPA), and Sale for Resale. MAWC uses rate classes A, J, and B, where Rate A includes residential, commercial, small industrial and OPA. Rate J is large industrial. Rate B is sale for resale. The St. Louis Metro district currently has the Rate A, J, and B classifications, whereas the other districts have separate customer classes and rates for residential, commercial, industrial and OPA which Staff has retained in its scenario.
- 3. In response to question 1.a, with the scenario as proposed by the Commission, there is no shortfall to the Arnold sewer district.
- 4. In response to question 1.b, with the scenario as proposed by the Commission, there is no effect on customer rates for each water and sewer district because there is no shortfall to the Arnold sewer district.
- 5. In response to question 2.a, with the scenario as proposed by the Commission, there is no shortfall to the Arnold sewer district.
- 6. In response to question 2.b, with the scenario as proposed by the Commission, there is no effect on customer rates for each water and sewer district because there is no shortfall to the Arnold sewer district.

WHEREFORE, Staff prays that the Commission will accept Staff's Response to

its Order Directing Staff to Prepare Scenarios.
