The Missouri Public Service Commission is ordering that any further filings regarding main extensions and consolidated tariffs shall be made in Missouri-American Water Company's separate pending rate action. The final report included illustrative tariffs addressing the issues assigned to those groups respectively. Also on July 1, 2011, the City of Joplin filed a separate notice stating that the recent tornado had prevented its review of collaborative group efforts and reserving comment on the illustrative tariffs for the rate action. The Commission will order no further reports from those groups and will direct that any further filings regarding main extensions and consolidated tariffs shall occur in the pending rate action.
