  - b.) Missouri-American Water Company, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall bring sufficient copies of a one-page statement outlining their current assessment of the case for distribution at the questionand-answer session.

c.) Missouri-American Water Company, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer session.

d.) Any other party, at its discretion, may prepare a statement and make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question and

answer session.

4. The local public hearings shall be held in facilities that meet the accessibility
