NOTICE AND ORDER SETTING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING

Hickory Hills Water & Sewer Co., Inc. (“the company”) filed rate increase requests¹ that are now the subject of a disposition agreement (“agreement”).² The agreement proposes a full resolution of the rate increase requests and is signed by the company and the Commission’s staff. The Office of the Public Counsel did not join in the agreement and requested a local public hearing at which interested persons may testify.³ The Commission granted that request⁴ and will set the local public hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Setting. The Commission will convene a local public hearing in the Public Meeting Room of the City Hall, north entrance, 500 South Oak, California, Missouri 65018, on July 29, 2014. The local public hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. with a question-and-answer session. When the question-and-answer session concludes, the Commission will take testimony.
