

3. On September 30, 2015, attorney Jennifer Hernandez entered her appearance for Respondents and moved to set aside the default determination. There

being no objections, the Commission granted Respondents' motion and set aside the default determination on October 8, 2015.

4. On November 3, 2015, the Commission granted Respondents' *Motion to Stay*, filed on October 22, 2015, and directed that a status report be filed not later than December 4, 2015.

5. Staff states that conversations with Respondents continue. In particular, Respondents are reviewing their options, whether to seek a certificate and become a regulated entity or to convert to a non-profit, non-regulated entity. Staff continues to hope that an amicable settlement will be reached. Staff will move to re-activate its *Complaint* if Respondents have not decided what they are going to do within the next 60 days.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits its *Status Report* and recommends the Commission issue an order directing further status reports at monthly intervals.
