On October 22, 2015, the Respondents, Fawn Lake Water Corp. and Rachel Hackman, filed a motion asking the Commission to stay proceedings in this complaint case to allow the Respondents to work with Staff and Public Counsel to attempt to amicably resolve the complaint. The Respondents also offered to file a status report in thirty days to keep the Commission apprised of developments.
