On December 15, 2015, the Staff of the Commission filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against The Willows Utility Company alleging that the company failed to file its annual report. On January 14, Staff file a motion asking the Commission to dismiss its complaint, explaining that the company has now filed the required report.

Although Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to dismiss its complaint, Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) provides that a complainant may voluntarily dismiss its complaint at any time before prepared testimony has been filed without an order from the Commission. No prepared testimony has been filed in this case, so the

Commission will simply acknowledge Staff's dismissal of its complaint. This file may now be closed.
