 - 3. The parties shall comply with the following additional procedural requirements:
 - A. All parties shall bring an adequate number of copies of exhibits that they intend to offer into evidence at the hearing. If testimony or documents are pre-filed and served on the parties before a hearing, a party need only provide a copy of the testimony or document to the court reporter as an exhibit at the evidentiary hearing. If an exhibit has not been prefiled, the party offering it must bring, in addition to the copy for the court reporter, copies for the five Commissioners, the Presiding Judge, and all counsel.
