- Q. HAVE YOU READ MS.LAMBERTS QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS REGARDING THE CHRONOLOGICAL SEQUENCE OF EVENTS RELATED TO THE EVENTS THAT TOOK PLACE AT 6303 EVANSTON, RAYTOWN, MISSOURI?
- A. YES

- Q. DO YOU CONCUR WITH THE ANSWERS MS.LAMBERT GAVE TO THE SEQUENCE OF EVENTS AS IT PERTAINED TO YOUR PERSONAL INVOLVEMENT?
- A. NO. ON ABOUT NOVEMBER 30 DECEMBER 1, 2003, I REQUESTED GAS SERVICE TO BE PLACED IN MY NAME AT THE ADDRESS OF 6303 EVANSTON, RAYTOWN, MISSOURI AND WAS INFORMED BY THE CUSTOMER SERVICE PERSONNEL THAT I WOULD HAVE TO PAY AN OUTSTANDING GAS BILL OF \$760.88 BEFORE I COULD RECEIVE GAS SERVICE. I EXPLAINED TO A MS. SIMMONS THAT I HAD NOT BEEN A PRIOR MGE CUSTOMER AT THIS ADDRESS, THEREFORE I DID NOT FEEL RESPONSIBLE FOR A TENANTS GAS BILL. A COUPLE OF DAYS LATER I WAS INFORMED BY A MGE EMPLOYEE, BY THE NAME OF DAVID ?, THAT I WOULD BE REFUSED GAS SERVICE UNTIL THE OUTSTANDING GAS BILL WAS PAID.

- 1 Q. AFTER BEING REFUSED GAS SERVICE WHAT COURSE OF ACTION DID YOU
  2 TAKE?
  3 A. I CALLED THE MISSOURI PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION AND ASKED WHAT COURSE
  4 OF ACTION COULD I TAKE AND WAS INFORMED THAT I WOULD HAVE TO SUBMIT
  5 MY COMPLAINT IN WRITING, WHICH I DID THE WEEK OF JANUARY 27, 2004.
- 6 Q. DO YOU CONCUR WITH MGE'S TARIFF AUTHORITY TO ASSESS A
  7 LANDLORD FOR GAS USED BY SOMEONE ELSE?

- A. NO. AS THE LESSOR, I HAVE A THREE-YEAR LEASE WITH A TENANT, READY-SET-GO, INC.
- Q. DO YOU FIT THE CRITERIA OF A CUSTOMER ACCORDING TO THE TERMS
  AND CONDITION OF THE TARIFF 3.02?
- 12 A. NO. I AM NOT PRESENTLY A CUSTOMER NOR HAVE I EVER BEEN A CUSTOMER AT THIS LOCATION.
  - Q. DO YOU FEEL THAT YOU HAVE BENEFITED FROM THE GAS THAT HAS BEEN PROPORTED USED AT 6303 EVANSTON, RAYTOWN, MISSOURI?
  - A. NO. SUPPOSEDLY THERE WAS NO GAS IN THE AREA OF THE BUILDING THE WHOLE WINTER OF 2001-2002 AND NO PIPES FROZE. I WAS CONCERNED IN NOVEMBER OF 2003 FOR THE UP COMING WINTER MONTHS WITH NO GAS HEAT EVEN THOUGH I PURCHASED TWO ELECTRIC HEATERS FOR THE PREMISES THEY WERE NEVER USED. THE TEMPERTURE NEVER GOT BELOW 45 DEGREES. RESIDUAL HEAT FROM THE REST OF THE BUILDING KEPT THE FACILITY CONSIDERABLY ABOVE FREEZING.
