ORDER APPROVING PARTIAL STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

Issue Date: February 19, 2014

Effective Date: March 21, 2014

On February 11, 2014, Lake Region Water & Sewer Company, the Office of Public Counsel, and the Commission's Staff filed a *Unanimous Partial Stipulation and Agreement* regarding several previously disputed issues. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.115(1)(B) provides that the Commission "may resolve all or any part of a contested case on the basis of a stipulation and agreement".

On February 14, 2014, Staff filed on behalf of the parties a reconciliation, which noted that the parties discovered an error in the accounting schedules attached to the *Unanimous Partial Stipulation and Agreement* as Appendices A, B and C. The Commission will require the parties to amend the accounting schedules prior to the effective date of this order.

After reviewing the stipulation and agreement, the Commission independently finds and concludes that the stipulation and agreement is a reasonable resolution of the issues addressed by the stipulation and agreement and that such stipulation and agreement should be approved.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Unanimous Partial Stipulation and Agreement* filed on February 11, 2014, is approved as a resolution of the issues addressed in that stipulation and agreement. The signatory parties are ordered to comply with the terms of the *Unanimous Partial Stipulation and Agreement*. A copy of the stipulation and agreement is attached to this order.
2. The parties will correct any errors in Appendices A, B, and C to the *Unanimous Partial Stipulation and Agreement* and file those amended documents with the Commission no later than March 20, 2014.
3. This order shall become effective on March 21, 2014.
