notify members of the Missouri General Assembly representing the residents in the service

area of the company and shall notify the news media serving the residents in the service

area of Roy-L Utilities, Inc.

6. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall notify the

county commissioners of Montgomery County, Missouri.

7. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
