NOTICE OF COMPLAINT AND ORDER SETTING TIME FOR ANSWER AND STAFF INVESTIGATION AND REPORT

On June 22, 2020, Claude Scott filed a complaint with the Public Service Commission against Missouri-American Water Company. A copy of the complaint accompanies this notice. Complaint to the Commission is authorized by Section 386.390, RSMo (Supp. 2018), and constitutes a contested case under Chapter 536 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri. Commission rules govern discovery and procedure in a contested case.¹

Because the complaint concerns less than \$3,000, this matter will proceed under the small formal complaint procedure, as provided by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.070(15). If any party believes this matter should not proceed as a small formal complaint, that party may file a motion requesting a change in case status.

complaint was filed, as provided by 20 CSR 4240-2.070(15)(D).

The Commission will send to Complainant a copy of its procedural rules and the

Commission's guide for complaints.

represented by an attorney.

4. The Commission's Staff shall investigate and file a report detailing its

findings and recommendations no later than August 6, 2020.

Commission's procedural rules, 20 CSR 4240 Chapter 2, and the Commission publication
