**ORDER ON RECONSIDERATION REGARDING  
MAIN EXTENSION AND CONSOLIDATED TARIFFS**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Motion for Reconsideration* ("motion") filed by Missouri-American Water Company ("the Company") on behalf of the Main Extension Collaborative Group and the Consolidated Tariff Collaborative Group.

In the motion, the Company asks the Commission to reconsider the July 5, 2011 order in part. The part at issue is the requirement that any further filings regarding main extensions and consolidated tariffs shall be made in the Company's separate pending rate action. That requirement, the Company informs the Commission, will cause more disruption than the convenience such requirement was meant to achieve.

Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any further tariff filings regarding main extensions and consolidated tariffs, made by the Main Extension Collaborative Group and the Consolidated Tariff Collaborative Group created by the *Report and Order* in File No. WR-2010-0131, shall be made in File No. WR-2010-0131.

2. This order is effective immediately on issuance.
