## ORDER SETTING TIME FOR OBJECTION TO TARIFFS

Terre du Lac Utilities Corporation (“the company”) filed substitute tariffs<sup>1</sup> as set forth in the *Notice[s] of Updated Staff/Company Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Company Rate Increase Request* between the company and Staff (“updated agreements”).<sup>2</sup> The updated agreements are the subject of no opposition from the Office of Public Counsel (“OPC”).<sup>3</sup> Therefore, the Commission will set a time for filing any objection to the substitute tariffs based on conformity with the updated agreements.

1. Any objection to the substitute tariffs described in the body of this order is due on August 11, 2014.
