ORDER DIRECTING FILING

The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing the parties to file a response to this order addressing the *Withdrawal of Request for Rate Increase in Annual Sewer and Water System Operating Revenues*.¹ That filing constitutes a motion for voluntary dismissal. On such motion, the Commission's regulations provide:

An applicant or complainant may voluntarily dismiss an application or complaint without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission. **Once** evidence has been offered or **prepared testimony filed**, an applicant or complainant may dismiss an action **only** by leave of the commission, or by written consent of all the parties.²

Because prepared testimony has been filed, the Commission will direct each party other than Hickory Hills Water & Sewer Company to file a response to this order stating whether the responding party consents to dismissal of this action.

1. No later than 12:00 noon on September 18, 2014, each party other than Hickory Hills Water & Sewer Company shall file the response described in the body of this order.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
