**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DEFER FILING
OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On May 5, 2015, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") against Ridge Creek Development, LLC; Ridge Creek Water Company, LLC; and Mike Stoner and Denise Stoner ("Ridge Creek"). On July 9, 2015, the Commission's Staff filed a motion requesting that the Commission defer the filing of a procedural schedule in this case until after the conclusion of File No. WA-2015-0182, in which Ridge Creek has applied for a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate the water system that is also the subject of this complaint. Staff explains that the resolution of File No. WA-2015-0182 may reduce or resolve issues in this case and avoid unnecessary duplication of effort. Ten days have elapsed and no party has responded or objected to Staff's motion.¹ The Commission finds the motion reasonable and will grant it.

¹ Commission Rule 4 CSR 240.2.080(13) states that parties are allowed 10 days to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's Motion to Defer Filing of Procedural Schedule filed on July 9, 2015, is granted.
