On June 8, 2015, the Commission issued an *Order Suspending Procedural Schedule*. The Commission's order incorrectly states that the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") did not submit a reply to *Staff's Response to OPC's Complaints and Motion to Consolidate Cases*.

On May 21, OPC filed *The Office of the Public Counsel's Statement in Opposition to Staff's Response*. OPC stated in its filing that it opposes Staff's request to consolidate OPC's complaints involving completely different respondents and different facts and allegations. OPC also asserts that Staff's request to hold the complaints in abeyance, pending completion of the associated CCN cases, is premature, unjust, unreasonable, and contrary to the law.

This Order *Nunc Pro Tunc* corrects the misstatement in the Commission's June 8 order.

- 1. The Commission's June 8, 2015, order is corrected *nunc pro tunc* to acknowledge OPC's filed opposition to Staff's response and motion to consolidate.
