On November 30, 2015, Cody's Cabins, LLC, Charles Chodrick and Brenda Chodrick, (jointly, "Cody's") filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Branson Cedars Resort Utility Company, LLC ("Branson Cedars"). The Commission will schedule a prehearing conference to discuss a potential resolution of the complaint and schedule an evidentiary hearing, if necessary.
