On July 31, 2014, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) submitted revised tariff sheets to implement a general rate increases in its water and sewer rates. Those cases were opened under File Nos. WR-2015-0301 and SR-2015-0302. On August 6, the company moved the Commission to consolidate these files.

Commission rules allow for the consolidation of cases with related questions of law or fact. Additionally, Commission rules² require responsive pleadings to be filed within 10 days. No party has filed a pleading to oppose Missouri-American's motion.

Because these cases involve related questions of law and fact, the Commission will grant the requested relief.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

Missouri-American Water Company's motion to consolidate File Nos. 1. WR-2015-0301 and SR-2015-0302 is granted, with WR-2015-0301 being the lead case.
