3. Auditing and Income Tax Preparation Fees

What is the appropriate amount of Hillcrest's auditing and tax preparation (accounting) costs to include in Hillcrest's cost of service? What is the appropriate allocated level of auditing and tax preparation (accounting) costs for Central States Water Resources to include in Hillcrest's cost of service? Should accounting costs incurred and paid in 2016 by Hillcrest be included in Hillcrest's cost of service?

4. Rate of Return

What is the appropriate capital structure for purpose of setting Hillcrest's allowed rate of return? What is the appropriate allowed ROE to apply to the equity in the ratemaking capital structure? What is the appropriate allowed debt rate to apply to the debt in the ratemaking capital structure?

5. Rate Design

How many classes should Hillcrest's customers be divided into for the purpose of designing rates for both water and sewer? What are the proper allocation percentages to be used to allocate expenses between the customer charge and volumetric rate? Should a rate increase be implemented all at once or phased-in over time?

6. Corporate Allocation

What is the appropriate corporate allocation percentage to apply to corporate costs?
