**ORDER STAYING EVIDENTIARY HEARING AND
SETTING FILING DEADLINE**

On August 5, 2015, the Commission issued an order scheduling an evidentiary hearing on Mr. Harter's complaint for September 15. On September 14, the Commission received notice from Missouri-American Water Company that the parties had reached a settlement. In light of the potential resolution of the dispute between the parties, the Commission will stay the proceedings in this matter.

Pursuant to Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116, a complainant may voluntarily dismiss a complaint by filing a notice of dismissal with the Commission. In the alternative, the Commission may dismiss a case for good cause after providing a minimum of ten days notice to all parties. The Commission will set a deadline for parties to file requests for an evidentiary hearing. Should no requests be filed, the Commission will provide notice before dismissing Mr. Harter's complaint.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The evidentiary hearing scheduled for September 15, 2015, is stayed until the Commission orders otherwise.
2. Requests for an evidentiary hearing shall be filed no later than September 28, 2015.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
