

Staff filed status reports on April 6, 2016, June 20, 2016, October 18, 2016, and again on January 26, 2017, indicating it is working with the company to resolve the concerns raised in the complaint. In those reports, Staff explains that a contract operator is operating and maintaining the water system and is handling business matters, and that the

system is now operating in compliance with the requirements of the Division of Natural Resources.

It appears that the problems that caused Staff to file its complaint have largely been resolved and that the complaint can be dismissed without prejudice to its refiling. Further, Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(2) permits the Commission to dismiss a case for lack of prosecution if no action has occurred in the case for 90 days and no party has filed a pleading requesting a continuance beyond that time. But before dismissing the complaint, the Commission will give Staff an opportunity to explain whether the complaint should be dismissed.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than May 5, 2017, Staff shall file a pleading explaining whether this complaint should be dismissed.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.


