The Missouri Public Service Commission is acknowledging the voluntary dismissal of this action and canceling the hearing.

Hickory Hills Water & Sewer Company (“Hickory Hills”) filed a *Withdrawal of Request for Rate Increase in Annual Sewer and Water System Operating Revenues*.¹ The Commission’s regulations provide that Hickory Hills may dismiss this action if all other parties consent in writing.² All parties have consented in responses³ filed this day.

Therefore, this action is dismissed effective on this date, and the Commission will cancel the hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. This action is dismissed on September 16, 2014.
2. The evidentiary hearing is canceled.
