By this application, Applicant seeks permission, approval and a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area of Warren County, Missouri, as set forth on the map attached to this application as <u>Appendix 2</u> and legally described by metes and bounds attached to this application as <u>Appendix 2</u>.
- 4. Marked as Appendix 4, attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes, is a feasibility study containing the estimated cost of the facilities during the first three years of operation in the area proposed to be served; plans for financing; proposed rates and charges; and an estimate of the number of customers, revenues and expenses during the first three years of operation.

- 6. There are no municipalities located within the proposed service area. Applicant has complied with all legal requirements of the Warren County Commission to operate in said county. A copy of a letter from the Warren County Commission is attached to this application and made a part hereof as <u>Appendix 5</u>.
- 7. Said sewer system meets all currently applicable requirements of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. A copy of the construction permit from the Department of Natural Resources is attached to this application and made a part hereof as <u>Appendix 6</u>. It is Applicant's understanding that an operating permit will not be issued until a certificate is obtained from this Commission.
- 8. There are no other public utilities or governmental bodies operating or rendering sewer service within the area proposed to be served and the City of Warrenton has no interest in providing service, as attested by the letter attached to this application and made a part hereof as Appendix 7.
 - 9. The area proposed to be served is rapidly being developed, especially due to its

proximity to Interstate Highway 70. There is already a central collecting system and an adequate treatment facility in place that will serve all the existing customers. Additional treatment facilities and collecting sewers will be needed in this service area as more of the area develops. When the current system is fully utilized, it is anticipated that there will be approximately 57 single family residences, 111 mobile homes, 10 apartments and two commercial customers. Therefore, a public need exists for adequate sewer service within the area proposed to be served and the public convenience and necessity will be promoted by the granting of the authority herein requested.

10. The granting of this application is in the public interest because it will present an opportunity for the public in the area proposed to be served to obtain and utilize sewer service which is otherwise unavailable, and make the area more attractive to develop, with the corresponding benefits of temporary and permanent jobs.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission issue its order:



North Oak - Sewer District Feasibility Report

Background

The owners of the company have been providing service to a few single-family residential customers and a small mobile home park. However, the areas adjacent to where they are serving are developing and that causes a need for a larger sewer system.

Purpose

The owners of the company saw a need for a sewer utility to serve the area. Since there is no other sewer utility to provide service in this area, the owners formed a sewer utility and are seeking a certificate of convenience and necessity from the MO. Public Service Commission (PSC) to serve the area described on attachment A.

Financing

The sewer system will be financed by stockholder loans and contributions from land developers and customers. Most, if not all, of the collecting sewers will be financed by contributions in aid of construction. The method will be described in the tariff submitted to the PSC for approval.

Plan

The collecting sewer system and treatment facility was designed by a professional engineer. All facilities were approved by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) before construction began. A treatment facility and some collecting sewer are already in place. Expansion of these facilities will take place when the demand for service dictates. The existing sewer system was approved by DNR. All future sewers, treatment, etc. will be submitted to DNR for approval before construction begins. See attachment B.

APPENDIX 4

Customers

It is anticipated that by the time the certificate of convenience and necessity is obtained from the PSC, there will be five single-family residential customers, forty-five mobile home customers, ten apartment customers and two commercial customers. The company expects to add fifty-two single-family residential customers and sixty-six mobile home customers over the next three years.

Operations

The management of the company will be furnished by one of the owners, Mr. Jim Vaccaro. The utility company will provide the day to day service to its customers and maintenance of the collecting sewer system. It has contracted with Hydro Services, an Illinois firm, that will provide the maintenance and operation of the treatment facilities. The utility company will keep the books and records. It will also do the billing and collecting. The utility company will maintain a 24-hour telephone answering service to handle emergency situations.

Tariff

The utility company, through its consultant, Bill Sankpill, will work with the PSC staff to develop its original tariff. The tariff rules will be submitted for approval as soon as possible after the PSC accepts the application for the certificate of convenience and necessity.

The proposed single-family residential customer rate is \$35 per month. The apartment and mobile home customer rates will be 80% of that rate. The commercial rate will be \$35 per month for the first 6000 gallons of water usage and \$3 per thousand gallons in excess of 6000 gallons of water usage.

Income and Expenses

A pro forma income and expense statement is on attachment C.

Conclusion

The sewer utility is feasible because the rates are within the normal range for a sewer utility of this size and because the income by the fourth year shows this company can stand alone and produce a sufficient revenue to pay its operating expenses and cost of debt.

Permit Conditions:

In addition to the requirements for a construction permit, land disturbance activities of five acres or more require a Missouri State Operating Permit to discharge storm water (10 CSR 20-6.200). The permit requires best management practices sufficient to control runoff and sedimentation to protect waters of the state. To obtain this permit, submit Missouri Forms E and G and a permit fee of \$150.00 to the St. Louis Regional Office.

An application for State Operating Permit must be received by the Department at least 30 days before the facility begins to receive wastewater and no more than 60 days before. The applicant shall state the date on which discharge is to begin. An original State Operating Permit will be issued for a period less than five years. The permit will then be eligible for renewal for up to five years or may be terminated. To be considered for renewal the permittee must, during the life of the initial permit: (1) demonstrate compliance with the effluent limitations contained in the permit, and (2) be in compliance with all terms and conditions of the original State Operating Permit.

An engineer's certification, in accordance with 10 CSR 20-6.010(5)(D), must be submitted at completion of construction, (form enclosed).

The recommendations of the State geologist shall be followed during construction of these facilities. Upon completion of construction, the Division of Geology and Land Survey, P.O. Box 250, Rolla, MO 65401, shall be notified in accordance with geologic evaluation ID#008-97.

In accordance with 10 CSR 20-8.120(6)(B) sewers shall be sufficiently deep to protect them from superimposed loads.

Leakage tests shall be performed in accordance with 10 CSR 20-8.120(6)(H)2.

Deflection tests shall be performed in accordance with 10 CSR 20-8.120(6)(G)5.
