On April 6, 2016<sup>1</sup>, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Extension. Staff explains that the parties continue to negotiate. Thus, Staff, on behalf of all the parties, asks the Commission to extend the deadline to file a complete or partial settlement agreement for 30 days.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) allows parties ten days to object to motions unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. The Commission issued no order to the contrary, ten days have elapsed, and no party objects. Thus, the Commission will take up the motion unopposed. The Commission finds the request reasonable, and will grant it.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Staff's Motion for Extension is granted.
2. The parties shall file a settlement agreement or other pleadings no later than May 6, 2016.
