On October 26, 2021, the parties filed a Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule. The Commission will order a procedural schedule, including an evidentiary hearing.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following Procedural Schedule is adopted:

Initial Briefs	February 14, 2022
Reply Briefs	February 22, 2022

2. Although not all parties may agree upon how each issue should be described or on whether a listed issue is in fact a proper issue in this case, the parties shall agree upon and file a list of the issues to be heard, the witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing, the order in which they will be called, and the order of cross-examination for each witness. The list of issues should be detailed enough to inform the Commission of each issue that must be resolved. The Commission will view any issue not contained in this list of issues as uncontested and not requiring resolution by the Commission.

3. Each party shall file a simple and concise statement summarizing its position on each disputed issue, including citations to pre-filed testimony supporting its position.

4. Briefs shall follow the same list of issues as filed in the case and must set forth and cite the proper portions of the record concerning the remaining unresolved issues that are to be decided by the Commission.

5. After the filing of direct testimony, in regard to discovery the parties shall have five business days to object to any data request and ten calendar days to respond. However, data requests served after noon on a Friday will be treated as if served the next business day. If a deadline falls on a weekend or a holiday, the due date will be the next business day thereafter.

6. The evidentiary hearing is scheduled for January 20-21, 2022, commencing at 10:00 a.m. on January 20 and 9:00 a.m. on January 21. Unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, the evidentiary hearing will be conducted virtually by WebEx. All parties

shall provide their emails and those of their witnesses to [Jackie.Keely@psc.mo.gov](mailto:Jackie.Keely@psc.mo.gov) no later than January 18, 2022, for WebEx invitations.

7. No later than January 18, 2022, all parties shall share their email addresses in order to circulate any exhibits which have not been prefiled which may be offered or used at the evidentiary hearing.

8. This order shall be effective when issued.
