On May 7, 2021, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed the above-referenced application. The application seeks, among other things, authority for MAWC to acquire and operate the assets of a municipal water and sewer system in Garden City, Missouri.

The Commission will direct notice of the application be given to the county commission, local newspapers, and members of the General Assembly representing residents of Cass County, Missouri. The Commission will also direct notice of the application to the General Counsel for the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and will further set a deadline for interested parties to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall provide a copy of this order and the Application to the County Commission of Cass County, Missouri, and to the General Counsel for the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

2. The Commission's Public Information Outreach section shall provide a copy of this order and the Application to the media serving Cass County, Missouri, and members of the General Assembly representing residents of Cass County, Missouri.

3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than May 25, 2021. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System ("EFIS") or with the Secretary of the Commission. Comments on the application can also be made in EFIS.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
