On April 21, 2022, the Commission issued an *Order Granting Request to Reopen the Record*. The order included a procedural schedule in which an evidentiary hearing was set for May 5, 2022. Subsequently, the Commission moved that hearing date to May 6, 2022.

On April 22, 2022, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a *Request for a Finding of Good Cause to Issue Subpoena Duces Tecum Less Than 20 Days Before a Hearing.* The request notes that Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.100(2) states that a subpoena duces tecum shall not be issued less than twenty days before hearing, except for a showing of good cause.

Staff requests a subpoena duces tecum for witness Craig Sabo and states that good cause exists to issue a subpoena duces tecum in this matter less than 20 days before the hearing because the Commission's order setting the evidentiary hearing was issued less than 20 days before the hearing.

The Commission agrees with Staff and will find good cause to issue a subpoena duces tecum less than 20 days before the hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Good cause exists to issue a subpoena duces tecum in this matter less than

20 days before the May 6, 2022, hearing.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
