MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE WAIVER REQUESTS

COMES NOW Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE), and for its *Motion for Additional Time to File Waiver Requests*, states as follows:

- 1. On January 5, 2007, a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement (Agreement) was filed in this case. Although not all parties were signatories to the Agreement, no party opposed it or requested a hearing.
- 2. On February 8, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued its *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement and Accepting* 2005 Integrated Resource Plan.
- 3. The Agreement included a timeline for certain events leading up to the filing of AmerenUE's next IRP filing in February of 2008. Part of that timeline included a deadline for filing a request for waivers of the Commission rules for Electric Utility Resource Planning, found in 4 CSR 240-22.010 *et. seq.*
- 4. The Agreement requires AmerenUE to files its waiver requests no later than April 5, 2007. However, due to the press of other cases at the Commission, work on these waivers is not yet complete. The parties have met to discuss these requests several times and the Company has circulated a draft of its proposed waiver requests, but all parties have not had time to comment.

5. In order to allow all parties an opportunity to comment, AmerenUE requests an additional two weeks to file its waiver requests. This extension would require the Company to file its waiver requests no later than April 19, 2007. AmerenUE has notified all parties of its intention to file this request and all parties have indicated they have no objection to this request.

WHEREFORE, AmerenUE asks the Commission to issue an order setting April 19, 2007, as the date by which AmerenUE must file for waivers of any portion of 4 CSR 240-22.010 *et. seq.*
