Page 4 1 The following proceedings began at 6:10 p.m.: 2 JUDGE HATCHER: Let's go on the record. First I would ask that everyone please mute themselves unless 3 they are going to be speaking or testifying. 4 That will 5 cut down on the noise level and prevent audio feedback. Today is September 12, 2022. 6 The Missouri Public Service Commission has set 7 8 this time for a local public hearing to give members of 9 the public a chance to comment about Missouri-American 10 Water Company's Application to Own and Operate the Water and Sewer System of the City of Stewartsville. 11 File No. WA-2022-0311. 12 The Missouri Public Service Commission 13 regulates the rates charged by public utility companies 14 15 in Missouri to ensure that those rates are just and The Commission also regulates the quality 16 reasonable. 17 of service and safety of the operations of public utilities. 18 The Commission is made up of five 19 20 Commissioners. The Commissioners are appointed by the 21 Governor to fixed terms and confirmed by the Senate. The Commissioners employ a staff of engineers, 2.2 23 accountants, attorneys, financial analysts, and other specialists in the field of utility regulation. 24 25 My name is Charles Hatcher. I am the
