NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF MEMBER

COMES NOW the Midwest Energy Consumers’ Group (“MECG”), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075(6) of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, and for its Notice of Withdrawal of Member respectfully states as follows:

1. On July 31, 2014, MECG filed its Application to Intervene in this case. Consistent with Commission rule, MECG listed its participating members. Included in those members was Wal-Mart Stores, Inc (“Walmart”). At the August 5, 2014 prehearing in this matter, the Presiding Officer granted MECG’s Application to Intervene.

2. On October 20, 2014, Walmart independently sought intervention in the case to address issues related to a special electric rate for Noranda, as well as other general rate case issues. On November 5, 2014, the Commission granted Walmart’s intervention.

3. Given Walmart’s separate intervention in this case, MECG now notifies the Commission, consistent with 4 CSR 240-2.075(6), that Walmart has withdrawn from MECG for purposes of this case.
