

ENGAGING IN THE UNAUTHORIZED PRACTICE OF LAW**


Comes now, Cathy Orlor, on her own behalf, and for her above
entitled response, respectfully submits the following to the
Commission:

1. On March 16, 2006, the Respondents filed a Motion with the Commission, requesting that the Complaints against them be dismissed, on the grounds that I, (Ms. Orlor), has engaged in the unauthorized practice of law, by regularly filing pleadings on behalf of the other complainants.
2. This allegation is denied. I have not filed any pleadings on the behalf of other complainants. I have been advocating on my own behalf, and the other complainants all agree with me.

3. If the Commission, however, finds my pleadings to be inappropriate and/or incorrectly written, I would like to suggest, simply striking the single letter "s" in Complainants, in each of the pleadings the Respondents make reference to. This would seem to be a simple remedy to the Respondents' argument that I represented other complainants in my pleadings. Treating the pleadings as being filed on behalf of the single Complainant filing them, is a much fairer remedy than dismissing the complaints.

Wherefore, the Complainant, respectfully requests the Commission: DO NOT DISMISS THE COMPLAINTS, on the grounds that I, (Ms. Orlor), has not engaged in the unauthorized practice of law.
