APPLICATION OF CAMARATO DISTRIBUTING, INC. FOR APPROVAL
OF INTERCONNECTION, RESALE AND UNBUNDLING AGREEMENT UNDER THE
TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACT OF 1996

Comes now Camarato Distributing, Inc. ("CDI") ("Applicants"), and hereby files its Application for Approval of Interconnection, Resale and Unbundling Agreement ("Agreement") between SWB and CDI under the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("the Federal Act") and would respectfully show the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") the following:

I. INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT REACHED

CDI presents to this Commission for approval an Interconnection, Resale, and Unbundling Agreement (Agreement) negotiated and executed pursuant to the terms of the Federal Act (Agreement, Attachment I). After extensive good faith negotiations between SWB and CDI, the Agreement was executed by CDI and SWB on August 9th and 19th, 1999. The Agreement includes three Exhibits and two Appendices, which are incorporated into the Agreement. There are no outstanding issues between SWB and CDI that need the assistance of mediation or arbitration.

II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

CDI seeks the Commission's approval of the Agreement, consistent with the provisions of the Federal Act and Missouri law. Applicant represents that the implementation of this Agreement complies fully with Section 252(e)(2)(A) of the Federal Act because the Agreement

is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier.

CDI respectfully requests that the Commission grant expeditious approval of this Agreement, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation. This is a bilateral agreement, reached as a result of negotiations and compromise between the parties.

III. STANDARD FOR REVIEW

The statutory standards of review are set forth in Section 252(e) of the Federal Act which provides as follows:

* * *

(e) Approval by State Commission

- (1) Approval required.--Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission. A State commission to which an agreement is submitted shall approve or reject the agreement, with written findings as to any deficiencies.
- (2) Grounds for rejection.-- The State commission may only reject --
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) if it finds that --
 - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates a g a i n s t a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or

- (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interests, convenience, and necessity.

The affidavit of Keith Camarato, President of Camarato Distributing, Inc., establish that the Agreement submitted herein satisfies these standards. (**Affidavit Attachments II**).


IV. MISSOURI LAW

V. CONCLUSION


For the reasons set forth above, CDI respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Agreement expeditiously.



AFFIDAVIT OF KEITH CAMARATO

Before me, the Undersigned Authority, on this 7 day of September, 1999, personally appeared Keith Camarato, of Camarato Distributing, Inc., who, upon being by me duly sworn on oath deposed and said the following:

1. My name is Keith Camarato. I am over the age of 21, of sound mind and competent to testify to the matters stated herein. I am President of Camarato Distributing, Inc., ("CDI") and have personal knowledge of the agreement between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWB") and Camarato Distributing, Inc., ("CDI") ("the Agreement"). I have served as negotiator for the Agreement on behalf of CDI and have personal knowledge of its provisions. The parties have negotiated diligently under the Telecommunications Act of 1996, culminating in an executed agreement by SWB and CDI on August 9th and 19th, 1999.

2. The Interconnection Agreement together with its schedules appendices incorporated therein are an integrated package and are the result of negotiation and compromise.

3. There are no outstanding issues between the parties that need the assistance of mediation or arbitration, if this Agreement is approved.

4. The implementation of this Interconnection Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. It will allow the exchange of traffic between SWB and CDI.


