ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On March 15, 2022, Foxfire Utility Company (Foxfire) filed applications in File Numbers WM-2022-0186 and SM-2022-0187, requesting approval of a transfer of assets from Foxfire to Ozark Clean Water Company (Ozark). Those cases were consolidated into the current case on March 16 and Ozark was joined a party on April 8. Staff filed its recommendation on June 28, recommending the Commission approve the sale and transfer of Foxfire's water and sewer assets to Ozark with certain conditions.

On July 8, 2022, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed its response in opposition to transfer, stating that the approval of the proposed transfer at the proposed price would be detrimental to the public interest and urging the commission to deny the requested transfer of assets. Foxfire and Ozark replied to OPC's response timely on July 21.

The Commission will schedule a conference to discuss the schedule and procedures needed to resolve OPC's objection to the asset transfer. All parties must appear either by WebEx or by telephone
