## ORDER SETTING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS

Issue Date: July 10, 2018

Effective Date: July 10, 2018

On June 13, 2018, the Commission issued its *Order Setting Procedural Schedule and Other Procedural Requirements*, but did not identify exact dates or locations for local public hearings. The Commission ordered the parties to submit proposed locations for local public hearings. The Commission's Staff (on behalf of the Office of the Public Counsel, Orange Lake Country Club, Inc. and Silverleaf Resorts, Inc., and Ozark Mountain Condominium Association, Inc.) filed proposed locations for local public hearings on June 27, 2018. The Commission will set the local public hearings based on the proposed suggestions.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make an informal presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the beginning of each local public hearing.
2. Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water), LLC d/b/a Liberty Utilities, the Staff of the Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer sessions. Any other party may choose to have a representative present.

3. No later than ten days before the local public hearings, Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water), LLC d/b/a Liberty Utilities shall provide notice of the hearings to each of its customers.

4. The Commission’s Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the media and the General Assembly representing customers in Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water), LLC d/b/a Liberty Utilities’ service area.


