ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

On November 2, 2020, Willie J. Harris Jr. filed a complaint with the Commission against Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC). The Commission conducted an evidentiary hearing on May 4 and 5, 2021. On May 10, 2021, the Commission issued an order providing that any initial briefs be filed no later than June 10, 2021, as agreed by the parties at hearing.

On June 10, 2021, MAWC filed a *Motion for One Day Extension* and requested an extension to June 11, 2021, for MAWC’s initial brief, due to the availability of counsel. MAWC’s motion indicates Staff does not object and Mr. Harris had not yet responded to an inquiry by e-mail.

As MAWC’s motion observes, reply briefs may be filed no later than June 24, 2021, so the requested extension will not result in any overall delay. The Commission will grant the request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party may file post-hearing briefs no later than June 11, 2021.

2. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this order to Mr. Harris by U.S. Mail addressed to Mr. Harris's address of record.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
