# ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: May 24, 2023

Effective Date: May 24, 2023

On May 23, 2023, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion moving the Commission for an extension of time to file its *List of Issues*<sup>1</sup>, which is currently due on May 23, 2023, pursuant to the current procedural schedule in this case. In its motion, Staff explains that the parties are still discussing the issues and the wording thereof, and request that the Commission extend the time for filing the *List of Issues* "up to and including May 30, 2023." This language does not allow the Commission to determine whether Staff intends May 30 to be part of the grace period requested, or to be the day the *List of Issues* should be due, so the Commission will extend the time for filing the *List of Issues* to May 31, 2023.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The Commission issued its Second Order Setting Procedural Schedule on May 3, 2023, adopting the parties' proposed procedural schedule and requiring the parties to file their Joint List of Issues, List and Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross Examination, and Order of Opening on May 23, 2023, and their Statement of Position on the Issues on May 30, 2023.

Staff also requested to modify the procedural schedule so that the Statement of Positions due on May 30, 2023 shall be due on June 6, 2023.

The Commission finds Staff's requests to be reasonable and will grant them.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's motion to extend the time to extend the dates the Joint List of Issues,

List and Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross Examination, and Order of Opening, and the

Statement of Positions on the Issues are due is granted.

2. Staff shall file the *Joint List of Issues, List and Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross Examination, and Order of Opening* no later than May 31, 2023.

3. The parties shall file their *Statement of Positions on the Issues* no later than June 6, 2023.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
