ORDER ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 20, 2020,¹ the Commission held a Procedural Conference. On April 7, the parties submitted a Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule. The Commission will adopt the following procedural schedule and requirements:

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following procedural schedule deadlines are established:

- Direct Testimony (Ms. Beecham) May 1
- Rebuttal Testimony (MAWC) May 22
- Last Day to Request Discovery May 29
- Stipulation of Undisputed Facts (All Parties) June 15
- Evidentiary Hearing June 25

2. An evidentiary hearing shall occur on June 25, 2020, commencing at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison
