ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On February 23, 2012, Robert J. Clancy filed this complaint against Missouri American Water Company. Council for Mr. Clancy has entered an appearance and now a prehearing conference and procedural schedule are appropriate to ensure a resolution. At the prehearing conference, the parties should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct and the interval necessary for its completion; the number of witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing. The parties should also be prepared to discuss the current status of settlement negotiations. It is expected that the prehearing conference will provide an opportunity for the parties to further pursue settlement discussions.

During the prehearing conference, the parties shall be prepared to discuss a proposed procedural schedule, which may include: dates for the filing of a list of the issues to be determined by the Commission and statements by the parties of their position on each such issue; a date for the filing of a list of the witnesses to be called on each day of

hearing, the order in which they shall appear and the order of cross-examination agreed upon by the parties; and date(s) for the hearing of this matter.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A prehearing conference shall be held on May 31, 2012, at the Wainwright State Office Building, 111 North 7th Street, Suite 105, St. Louis, Missouri, beginning at 10:00 a.m. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
