On January 21, 2015, the Commission issued a Report and Order. On February 18, Respondent Consolidated Public Water Supply District C-1 of Jefferson County filed an Application for Rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), provides that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if “in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear.” The Commission finds that Respondent Consolidated Public Water Supply District C-1 of Jefferson County has failed to establish sufficient reason to grant its application for rehearing. The Commission will deny the application.
